The eJournals Delivery Service (eJDS) is geared to facilitate the access to current scientific literature free of cost **in the fields of Physics and Mathematics**. The goal is to distribute scientific articles via e-mail to individual scientists in institutions in least developed or low income countries who do not have access to sufficient bandwidth to download material from the Internet in a timely manner and/or cannot afford the connection. Providing scientists with current literature supports their ongoing research.

In order to be able to use the free eJournals Delivery Service, it is necessary to register. Registration consists of two steps:

- 1) **Complete and sign the Application Form.** Please read the eJDS rules carefully before filling the form.
- 2) **Send the signed Application Form**
